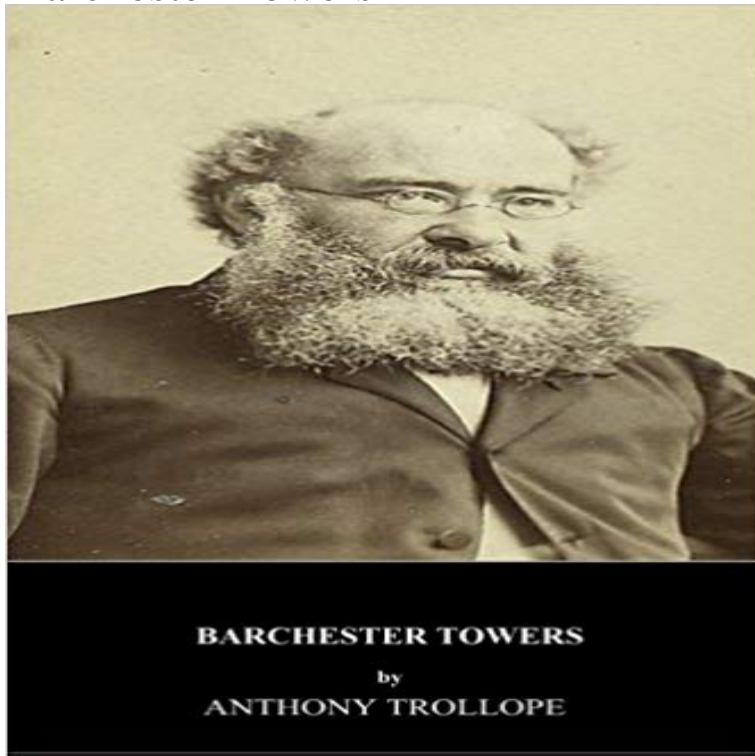


Barchester Towers
