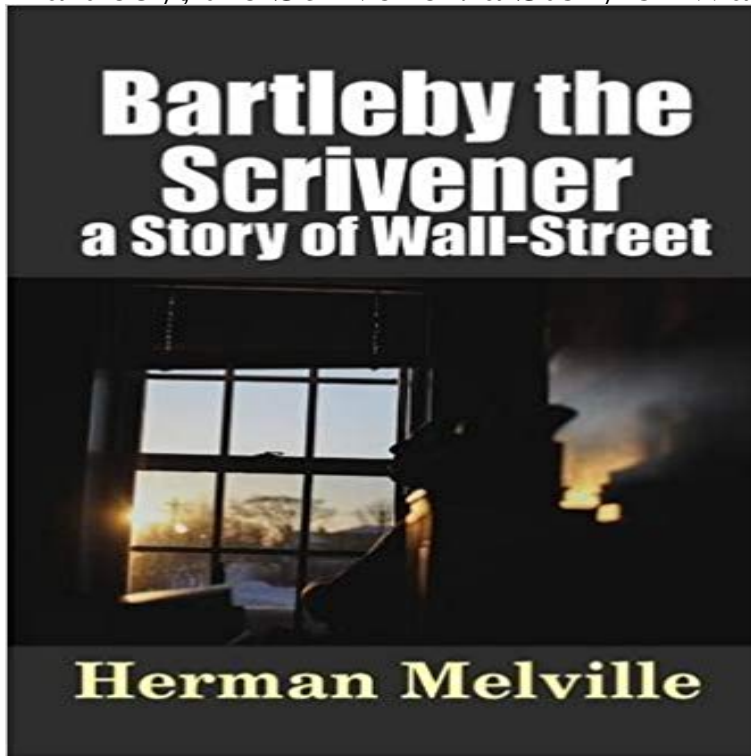


Bartleby, the Scrivener: a Story of Wall-Street

Bartleby begins to never leave the office, but repeats what he does all day long, copying, staring, and repeating his famous words of I would prefer not to, leading readers to have another image of the repetition that leads to isolation on Wall Street and the American workplace.
