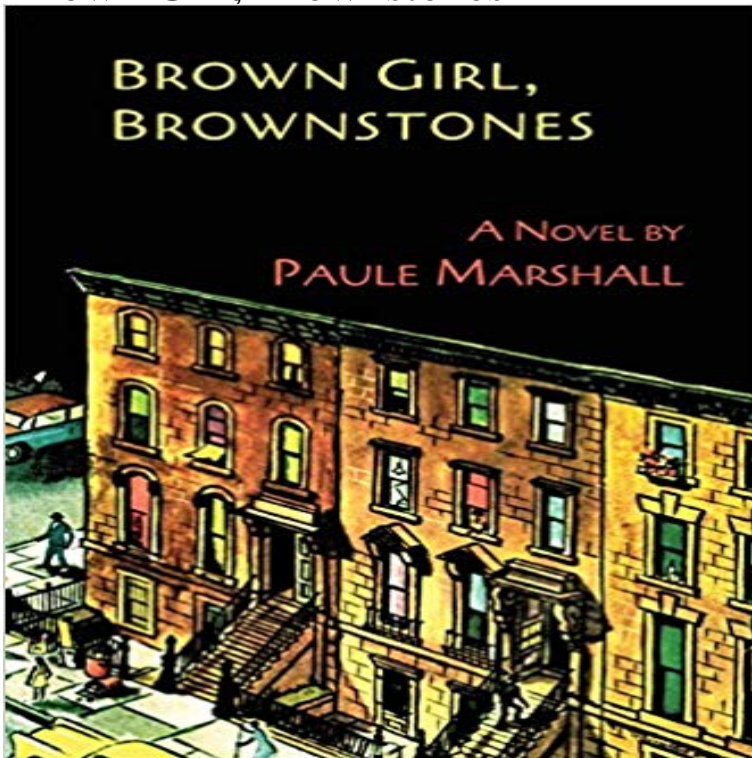


## Brown Girl, Brownstones

It remains a vibrant, compelling tale of self-discovery.
