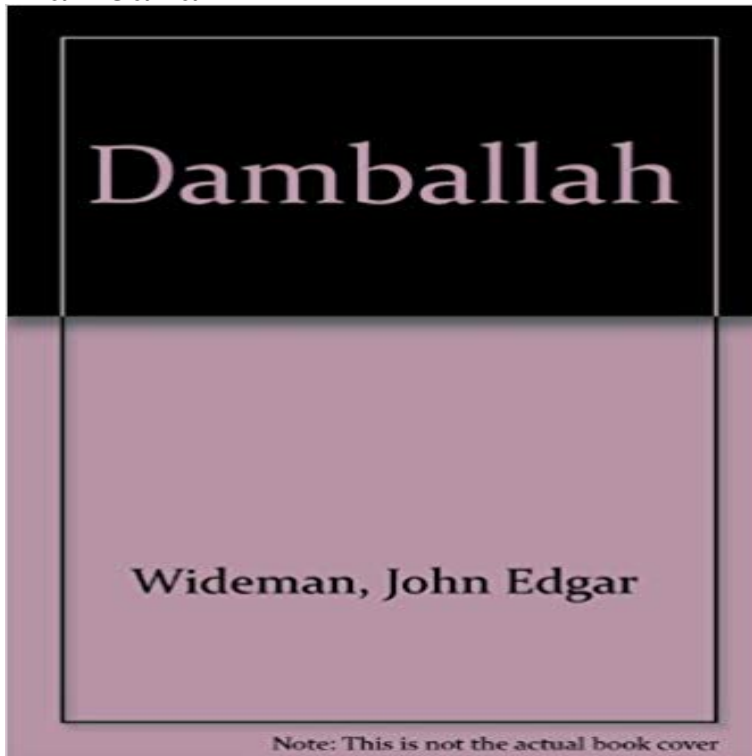


## Damballah
