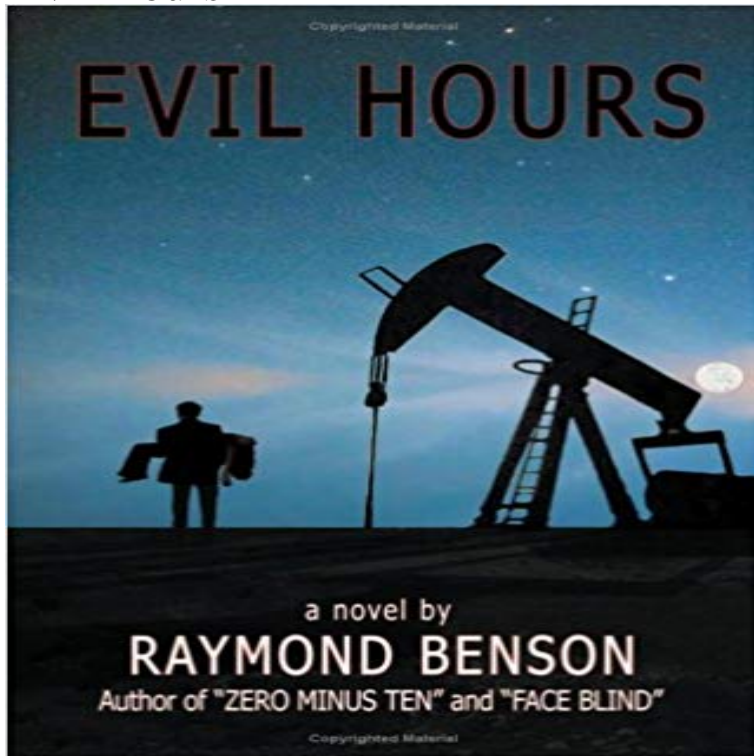


Evil Hours
