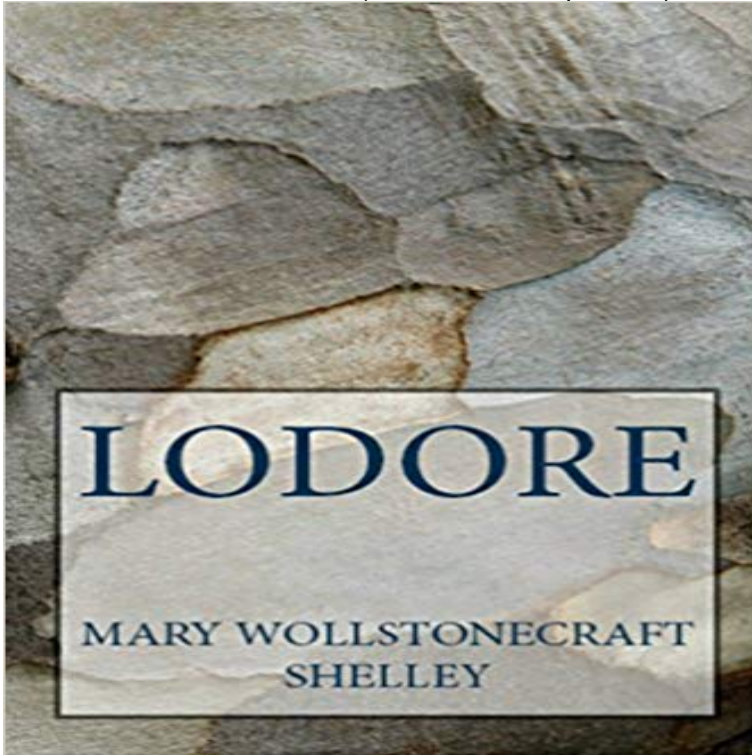


## Lodore & Falkner; A Novel (Mary Shelley Literary Classics Book 6)

About The Author Mary Shelley (nee Wollstonecraft Godwin 1797-1851) was an English novelist and travel writer best known for her Gothic book *Frankenstein: or, The Modern Prometheus* (1818). She was married to the Romantic poet and philosopher Percy Bysshe Shelley, her father was the political philosopher William Godwin, and her mother was the philosopher and feminist Mary Wollstonecraft. She died at age 53 after being diagnosed with a brain tumour. Her novels include the historical work *Valperga* and *Perkin Warbeck*, *The Last Man*, and her final two novels, *Lodore* and *Falkner*. Her travel books included *Rambles in Germany* and *Italy*.
