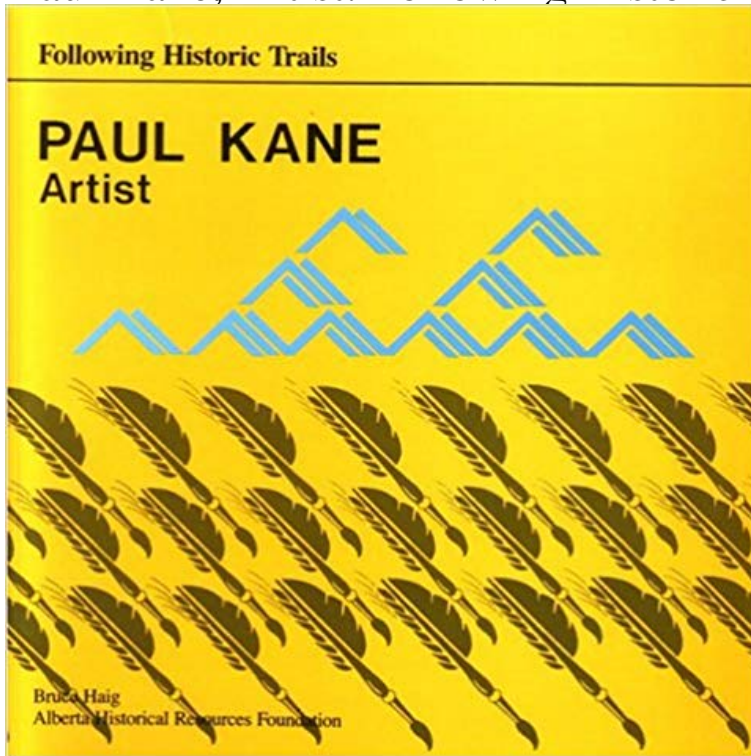


Paul Kane, Artist: Following Historic Trails



Follow Paul Kane, Canada's first and most outstanding illustrator of North American Indians, on his expedition through the Rocky Mountains in 1846-48 a journey which began at Fort Carlton near present day Saskatoon, and led him to Fort Edmonton, Rocky Mountain House, Athabasca Pass, and Jasper. Read about Kane's encounters with the Indians Assiniboine, Blackfoot and Cree which inspired his famous paintings. Excerpts from Kane's journal, condensed accounts of his travels, a representative selection of his work, as well as up-to-date map directions of his route recreate Paul Kane's colorful journey. Re-live the time of the Indian buffalo hunts and medicine pipestem dance, the exploits of the Hudson's Bay Company fur brigades, the days of arduous travel in winter over ice-choked rivers, and the comfort of simple food and shelter at each long journey's end.
