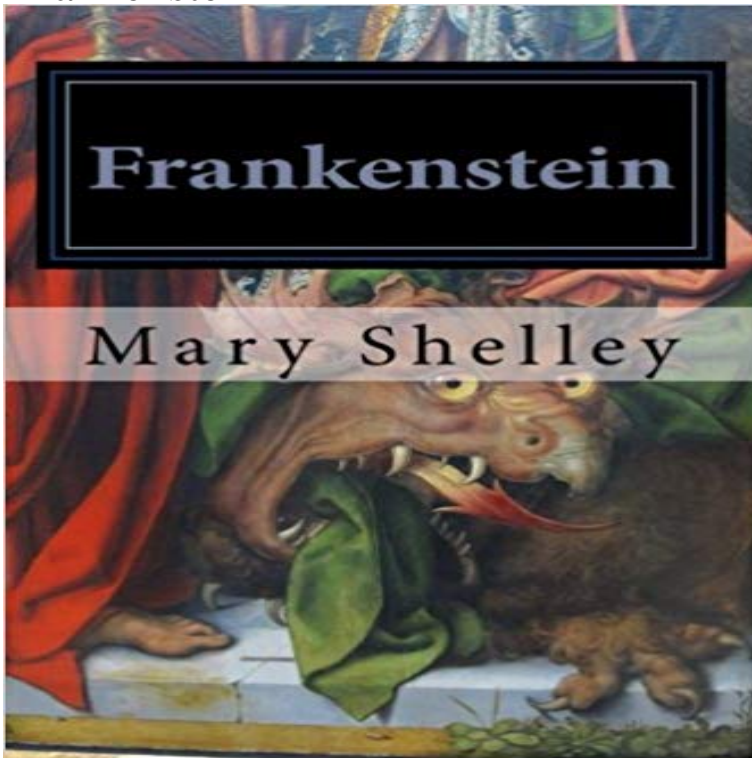


Frankenstein
