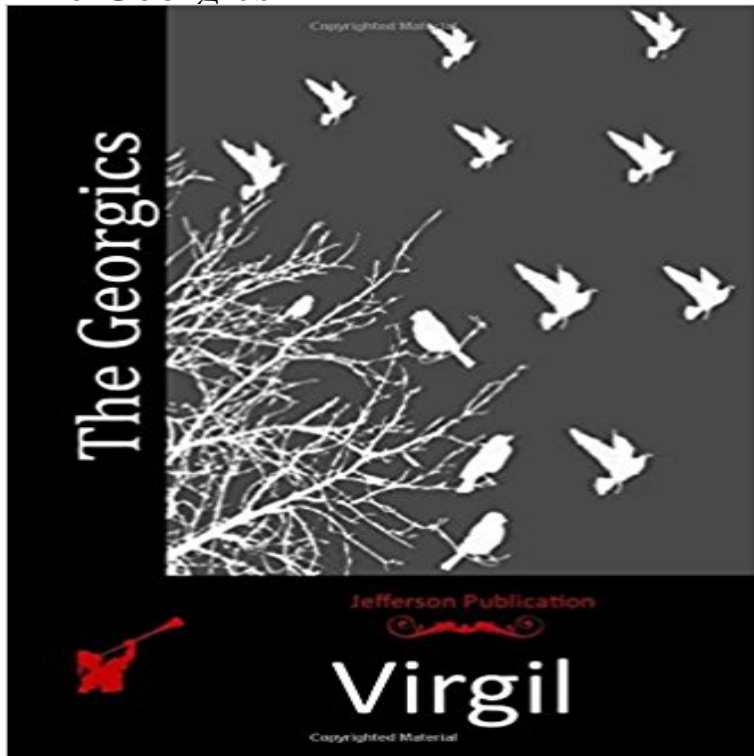


The Georgics
