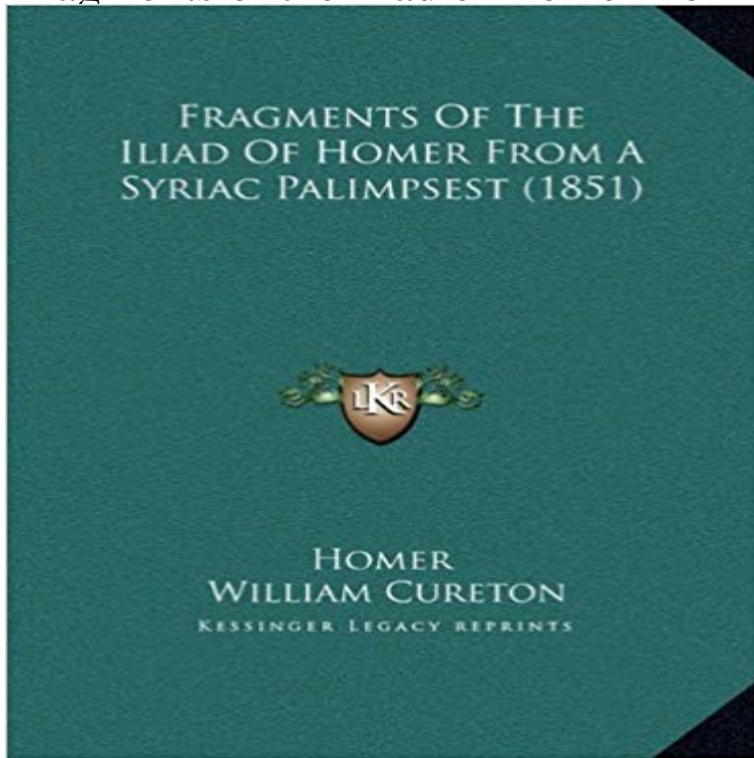


Fragments of the Iliad of Homer from a Syriac Palimpsest (1851)
