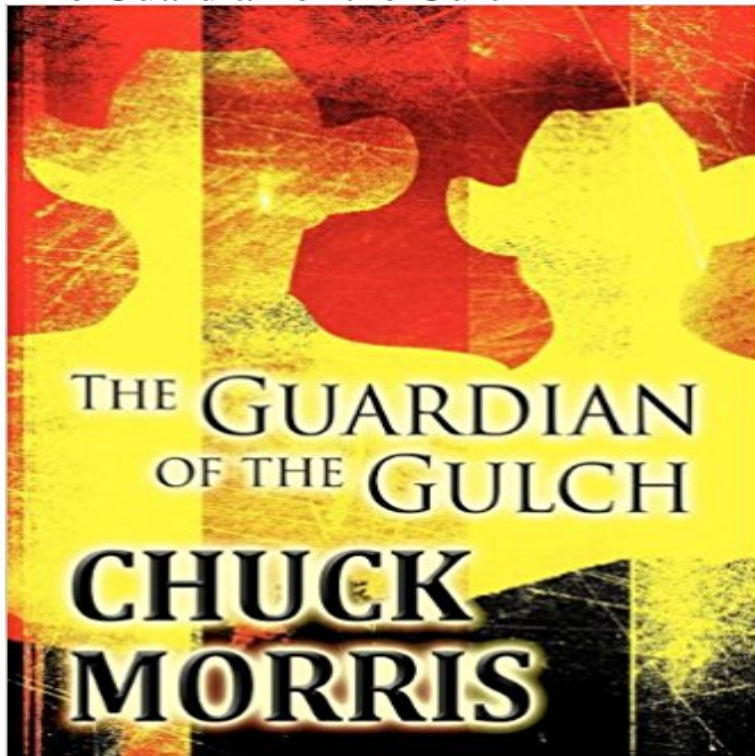


The Guardian of the Gulch
