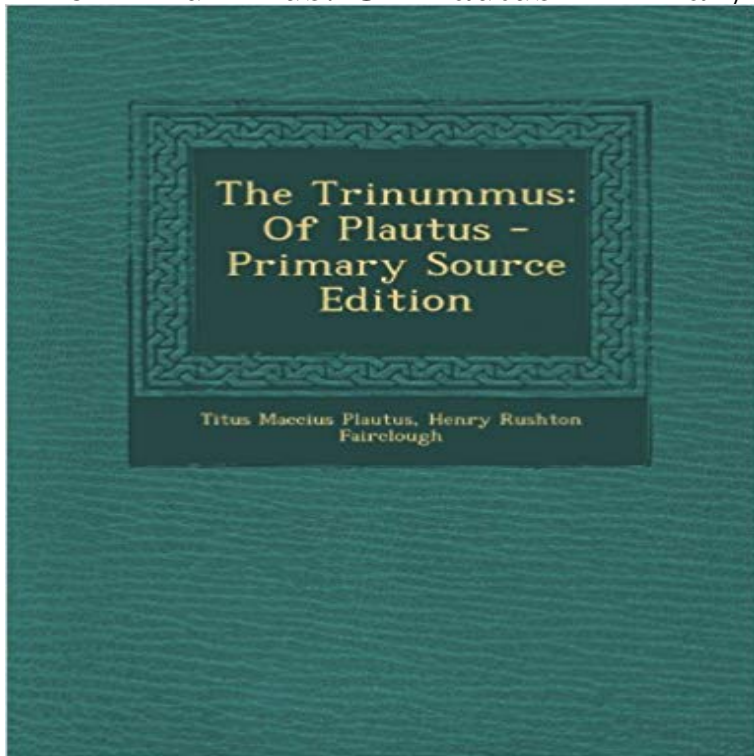


## The Trinummus: Of Plautus - Primary Source Edition (Latin Edition)
