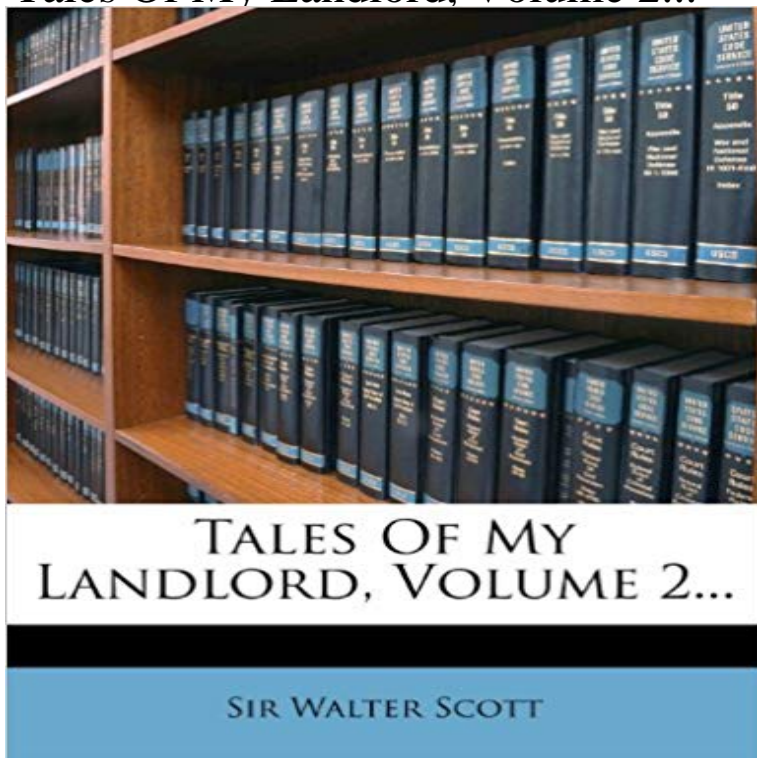


Tales Of My Landlord, Volume 2...
