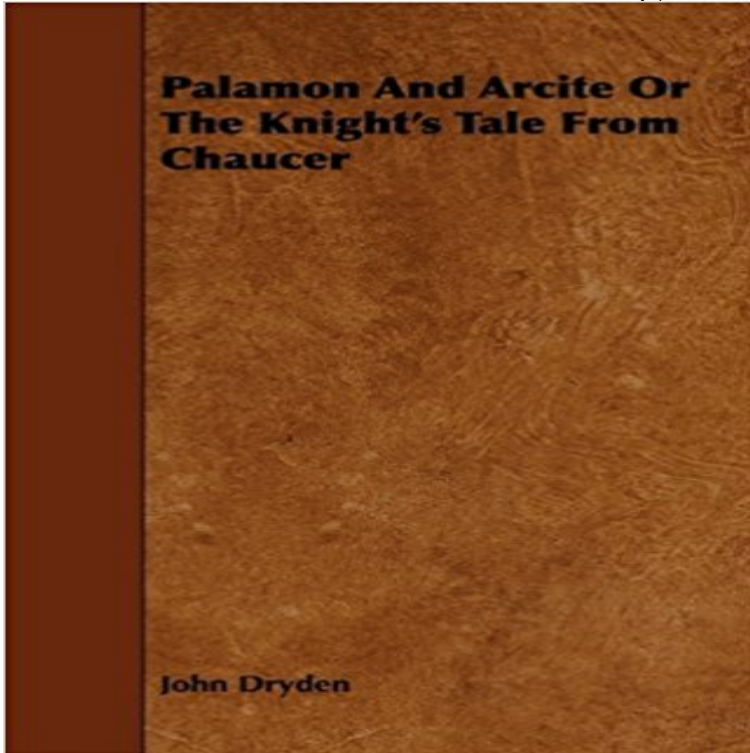


Palamon And Arcite Or The Knights Tale From Chaucer
