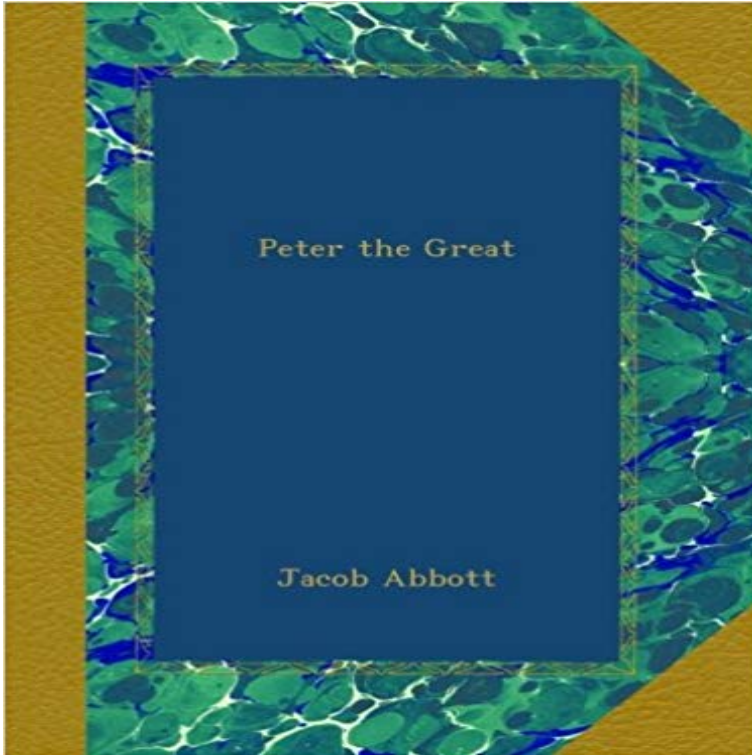


Peter the Great
