And therefore, if we are convinced of the hidden existence of this strange energy, without which human life is pointless, shall we be rational if we deny that such a thing as this mysterious Psychic Force has equally a place in Nature, if we witness certain phenomena unaccountable on any other theory? Some such process of reasoning as this was probably in Serjeant Cox's mind when he commenced his investigation of the great problem, What am I? As Serjeant Cox is not a professed surgeon, physician, or analytical chemist, there are many

statements on scientific subjects relating to the laws of human existence which we may not take...
