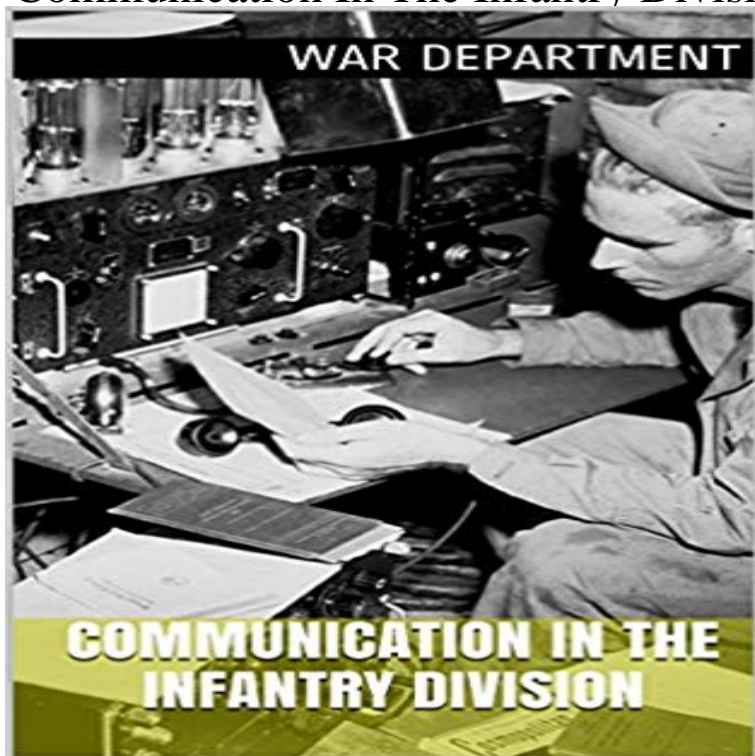


Communication In The Infantry Division: 1944

The infantry division, division signal company, infantry regiment, division artillery, engineer battalion, and cavalry reconnaissance troop, mechanized, are described.
