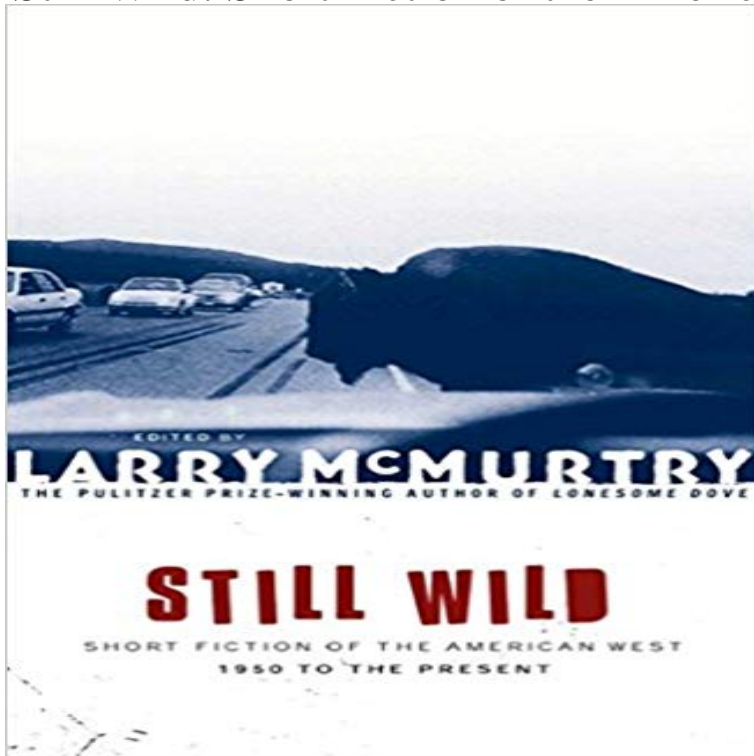


Still Wild: Short Fiction of the American West 1950 to the Pre
