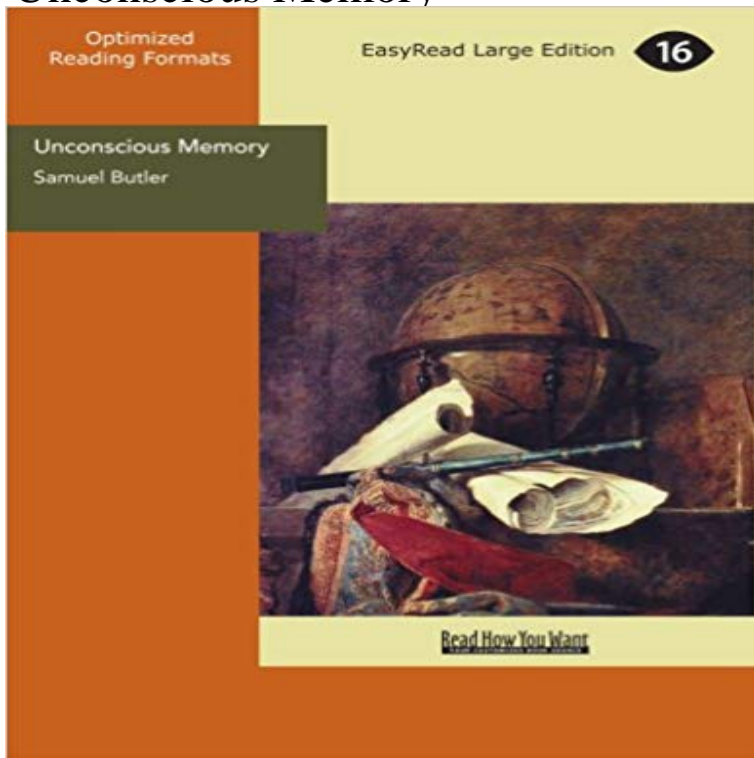


# Unconscious Memory
