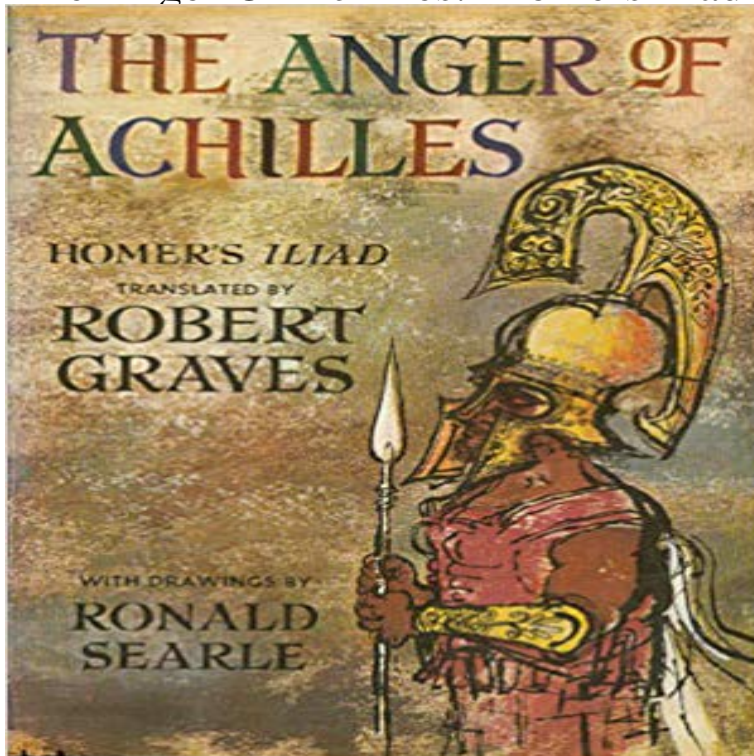


The Anger Of Achilles: Homers Iliad
