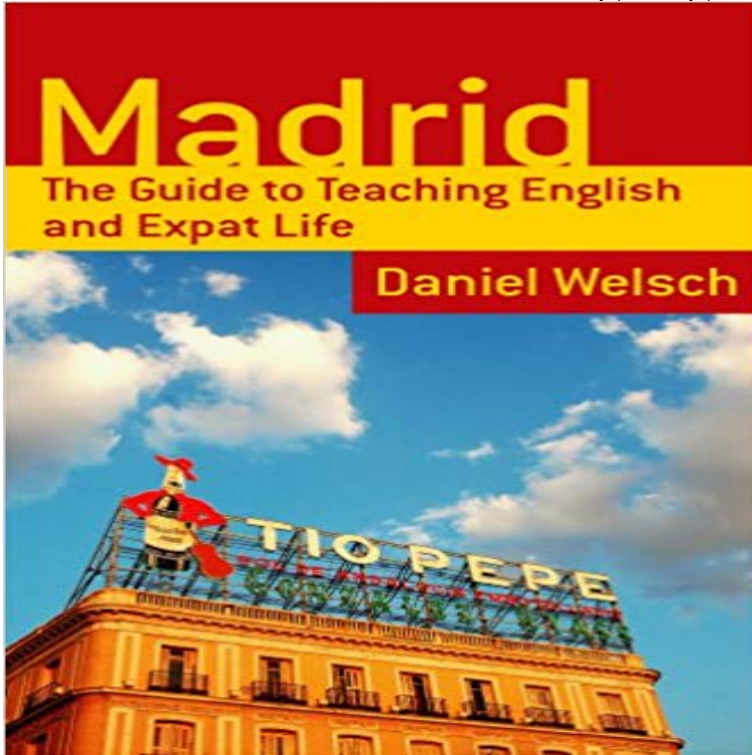


Madrid: The Guide to Teaching English and Expat Life
