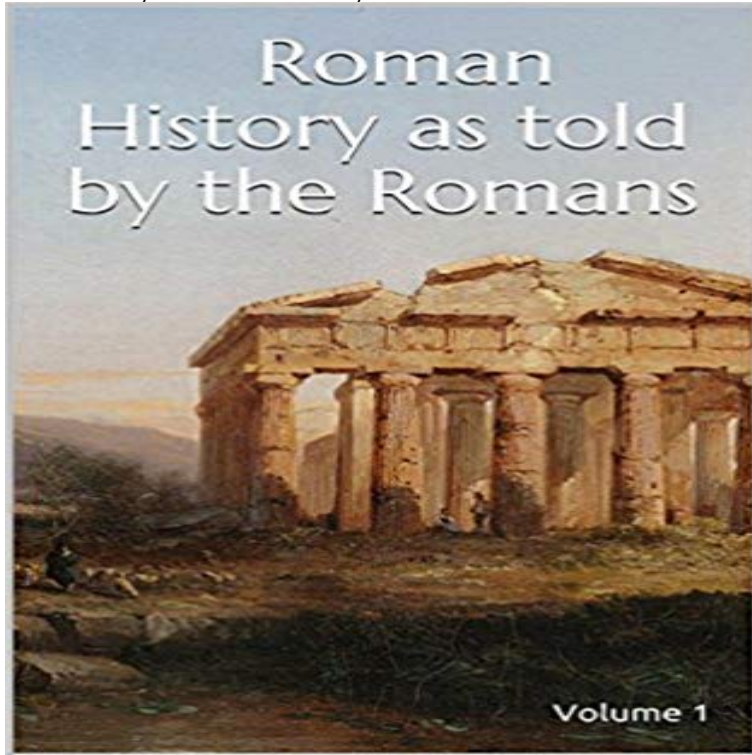


Rome from Earliest Times to the Dawn of the Second Punic War (Roman History as Told by the Romans Book 1)
