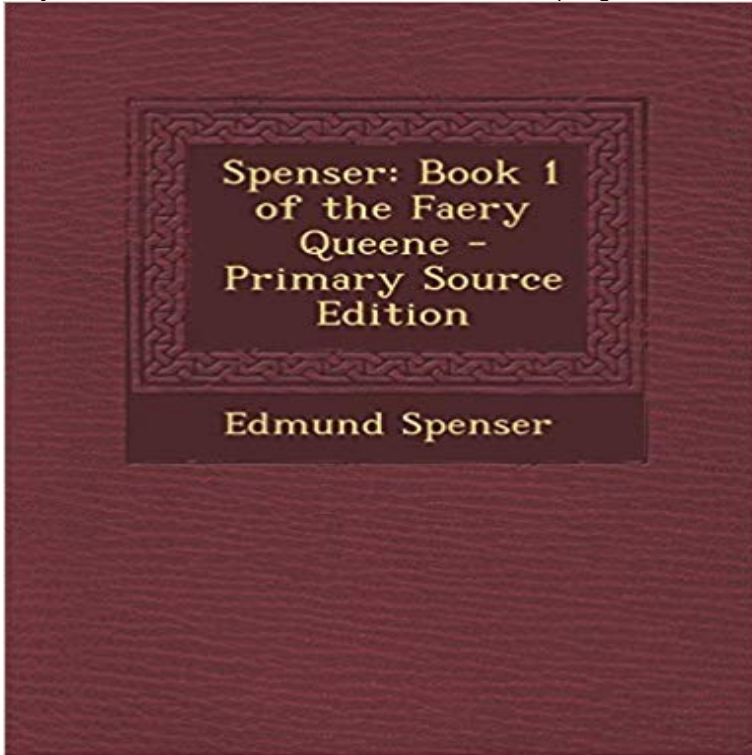


## Spenser: Book 1 of the Faery Queene - Primary Source Edition
