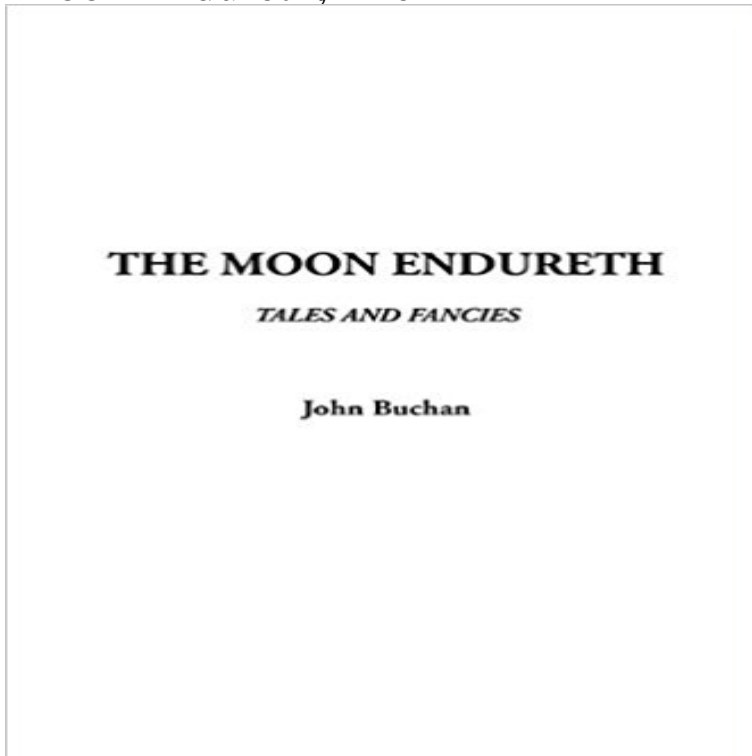


Moon Endureth, The
