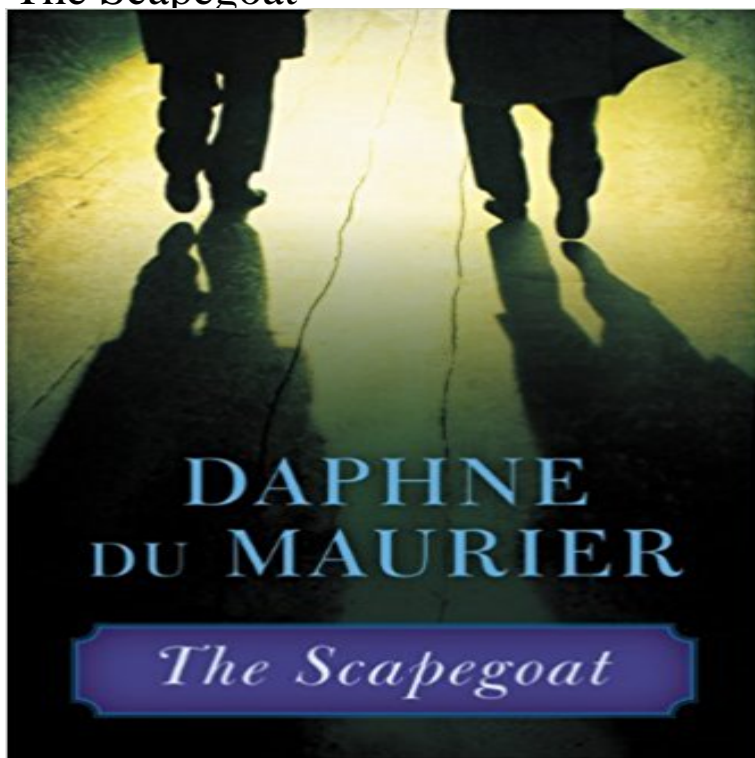


The Scapegoat
