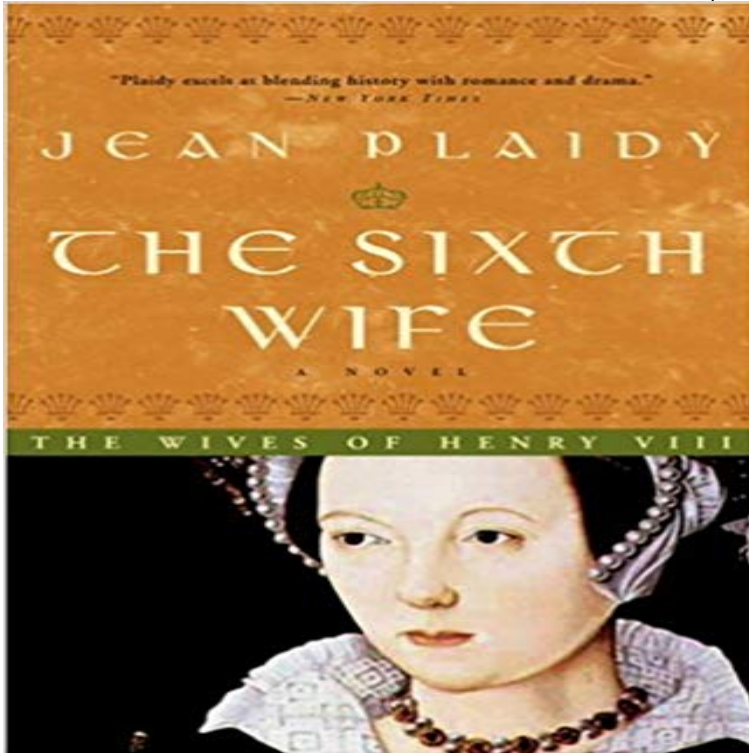


The Sixth Wife: The Wives of Henry VIII
