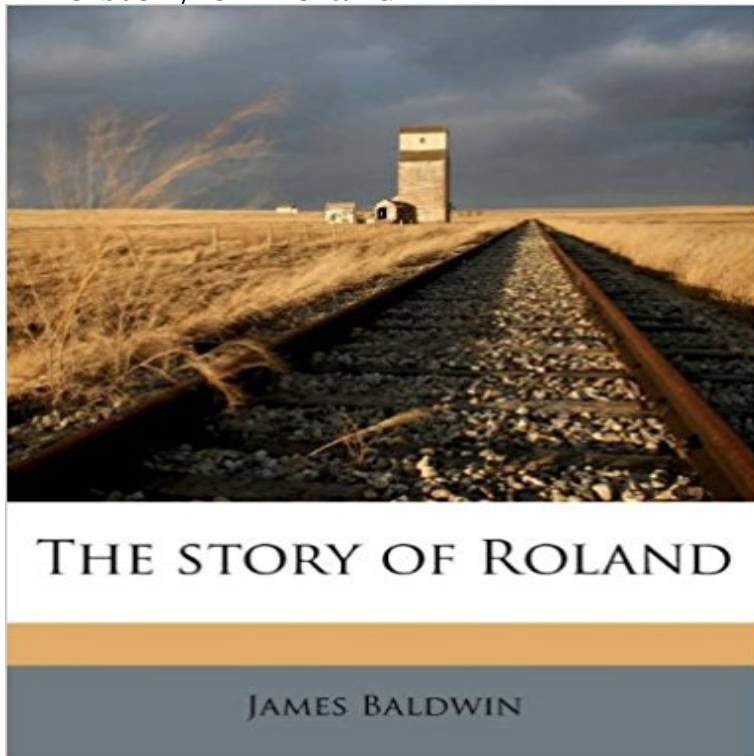


## The story of Roland
