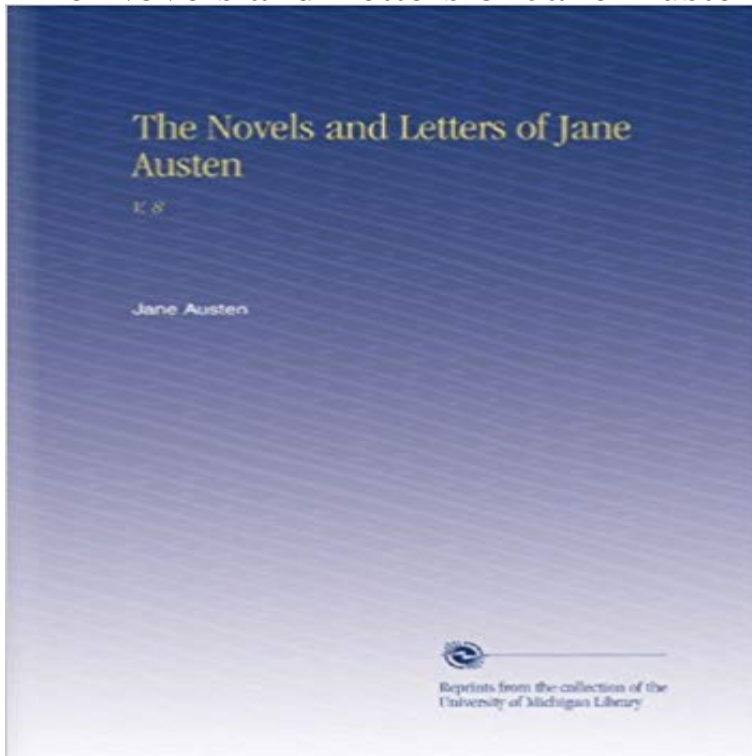

The terror which the woman and boy had been creating in Harriet was then their own portion. He had left them completely frightened; and Harriet eagerly clinging to him, and hardly able to speak, had just strength enough to reach Hartfield, before her spirits were quite overcome. It was his idea to bring her to Hartfield; he had thought of no other place. This was the amount of the whole story--of his

communication and of Harriets, as soon as she had recovered her senses and speech. He dared no...
