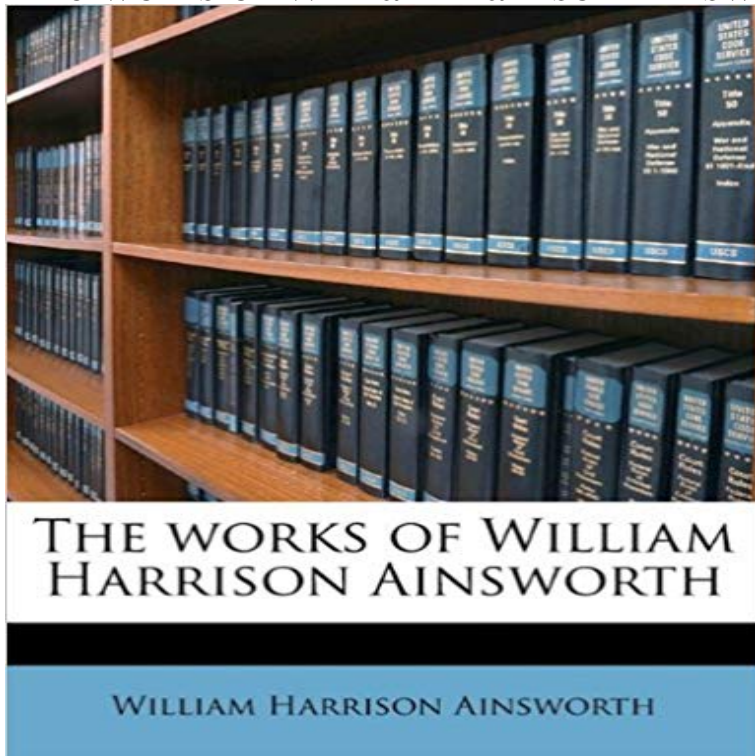


## The works of William Harrison Ainsworth Volume 2
