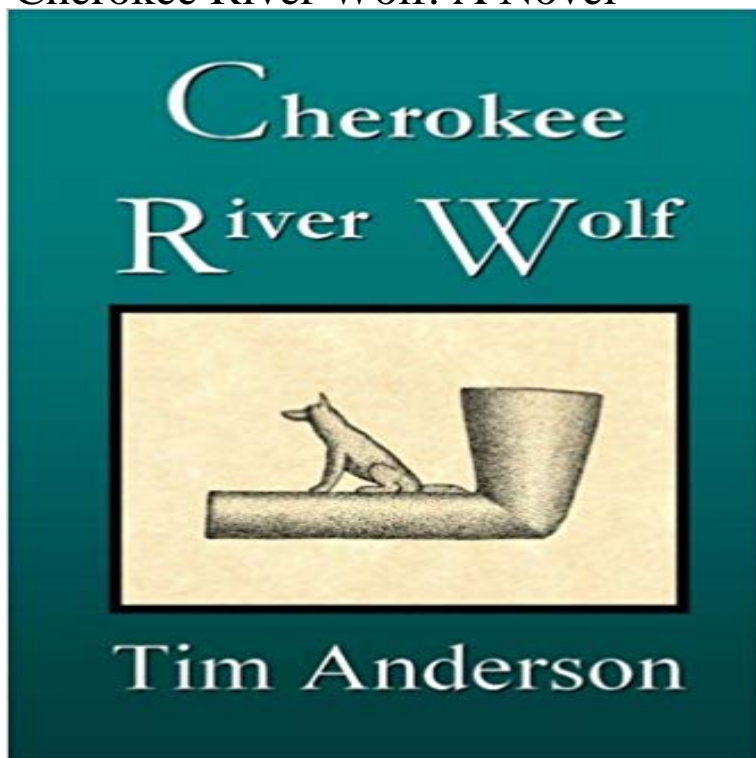


## Cherokee River Wolf: A Novel
