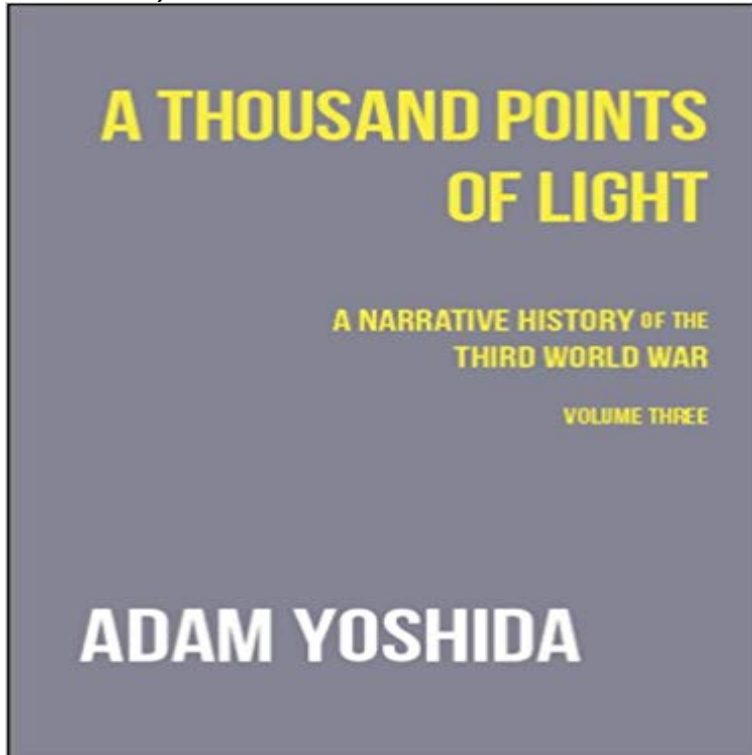


## A Thousand Points of Light (A Narrative History of the Third World War Book 3)
